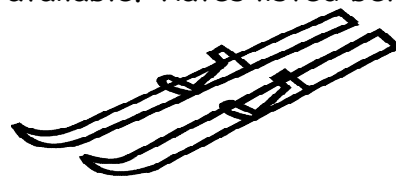
***1/14/12 Saturday: Beginning Cross Country Ski Lessons at Oak Hill Farms, Esperance.**

(Class times are 9:00AM, 11:00AM, and 1:00PM). 90 minute group lessons will cover basic techniques such as falling and recovery, and climbing and descending hills. **Instruction is \$5 for DACC members and \$10 for non-members. Limit-10 students per session.**

Younger students (Ages 6-13) are encouraged to sign up for the 1:00PM family session.

If you need equipment, ski rentals are available for our group at reduced rates. For those who want to continue skiing after the lesson, trail passes are also available. Rates listed below.
